



1. Click “Start”, and then “Control Panel”. Next click “Network and Internet Connections”. Click “Set up or change your Internet connection”.




2. Click the “Connections” tab, and then “Setup”



3. This will start the “New Connection Wizard”




4. Choose “Connect to the Internet”, and then click “Next”



5. Choose “Set up my connection manually”, and click “Next”



6. Choose “Connect using a dial-up modem”, and click “Next”




7. Enter "Internet Partners", and click "Next"

9. Enter your “User name”, “Password”, check all of the boxes, and click “Next” **Note:** these items are case sensitive








11. At this point we need to check the settings so click “Network and Internet Connections”




12. Click “Network Connections”




13. Right mouse click on “Internet Partners”, and choose “Properties”




14. Under the General Tab click the “Configure” button under the “Connect using” That shows the modem.




15. Next Uncheck “Enable modem compression”



16. Next under the Networking Tab click on the Settings button




17. Make sure that “Enable software compression” is the only thing checked




18. Next choose the “Advanced” tab then the “Settings” button




19. Make sure that the Firewall “On recommended” is checked




20. When you start Internet Explorer as an example the connection box will pop up, and to start click “Connect”
