## How to setup Thunderbird eMail

When you open Thunderbird for the first time you may be asked if you wish to run import. This is up to you as a personal preference. On this next screen you will be asked the type of account choose "Email account".

Next enter the name you wish to have show up as the "From" to the person you are sending the eMail under "Full Name" [i.e. John Smith], and your "Email Address" [i.e. John\_Smith@ipinc.net]. Note make the case of each the way you want to as eMail addresses are not case sensitive.
